Colleges and Universities that have recognized University of Wisconsin Oshkosh credits earned through CAPP

The following list of colleges and universities is based on annual survey responses from former Cooperative Academic Partnership Program (CAPP) students and our office contacting these schools. **This is not an all-inclusive list and can change. Please ask at your college or university about transferring your credits.** Consistently, 99% of the students who request credit recognition for their UW Oshkosh credits earned through CAPP are successful. This list of colleges and universities recognizing UW Oshkosh credit earned through CAPP is NOT definitive! Please keep in mind:

- If a specific school does not appear on this list it does not necessarily mean it does not recognize credit. It may mean no former student has attended there or requested to know about going there.
- **This list does not represent a guarantee that all UW Oshkosh credits earned through CAPP will be automatically recognized by every college or university listed.**
 Recognition of credit varies from department to department within the same university or college. We encourage every student to save the syllabus and written work from their CAPP courses, and to request credit recognition directly from the appropriate department at the college or university to which they are applying. Please contact and refer to the policies of that college or university to properly transfer your credits.
- Remember to request an official transcript from UW Oshkosh in order to transfer your credits.
- Credit recognition can mean various things and varies by college/university and departments:
 1. Transfer of course with credits earned (as elective, general elective course, or degree course)
 2. Exemption from a required course because a comparable course was successfully completed through CAPP
 3. Placement in an advanced course because the introductory level course was successfully completed through CAPP
